

Are You Interested in Becoming a CCR&R Trainer?

- Are you an experienced early childhood professional who feels you have valuable information to share with others?
- Do you enjoy talking with people and helping others learn new ways of doing things?
- Are you interested in working to improve the care environments provided to young children in child care?

If so, Child Care Resource and Referral would like to talk with you.

Child Care Resource and Referral is looking for a few great trainers; perhaps you are just the person we hope to find. CCR&R trainers present our Core Curriculum training sessions to child care providers, in topics that cover the range of child development and early childhood programming. Our trainers work with us to build the knowledge and skills of those who provide direct care to young children in child care.

CCR&R trainers have education and experience in early childhood, as well as demonstrated adult learning skills. Our trainers are active in the field of early childhood, holding a variety of positions in child care settings or with agencies that provide early childhood services. They are contracted to present CCR&R training on evenings and weekends, on an as-needed basis. Trainers are paid an hourly rate ranging from \$25 - \$50 per hour, plus expenses.

To become a CCR&R trainer, first read the Trainer Job Description to see if you qualify. Then complete the Trainer Application form and return it to your regional CCR&R office. CCR&R conducts trainer interviews on an as needed basis. If approved, your application will remain on file until interviews are scheduled at which time you will be contacted to arrange an interview. Interviews include a 10-minute mini-training to demonstrate trainer skills. Selected CCR&R trainers complete a mentorship under the supervision of an experienced CCR&R trainer. Trainers are also evaluated on a regular basis and are expected to continually grow their own knowledge and understanding of good practices that support children's healthy development.
